Carnegie Avenue Rehabilitation Project – Phase 2
(East 79th Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Drive)
Public Information Presentation

When: March 7, 2024 at 5:00 pm

Where: PNC Fairfax Connection, 8220 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44103

What: To provide information regarding the Design of the Carnegie Avenue Rehabilitation project. **Final Design is scheduled to be completed in June 2024. Construction is scheduled to begin March 2025.**

The proposed improvements include:

- Full and partial depth pavement repairs as needed, and complete asphalt resurfacing
- New sidewalk, curb, ADA-compliant curb ramps and drive aprons as necessary
- Replacement of an existing 8" water main with a 12" water main from East 79th Street to Stearns Road
- Replacement of existing catch basins as needed
- Signal upgrades at East 83rd Street, East 90th Street, East 96th Street, East 100th Street, Stokes Boulevard, Stearns Road, MLK Jr. Drive and MLK Jr Drive/Cedar Avenue
- Utilize Thermoplastic Pavement Striping for durability and upgrade signage as necessary

Construction Cost Estimate: \$11.0 million

Funding Sources: Ohio Public Works Commission-Issue 1, City Road & Bridge Bonds and Public Utility Funds
