Questions and answers, from the pre-proposal conference and received form potential proposers:

1. Ediscovery, forensics on mobile devices, cyber security?

Answer: State qualifications in these areas as part of the technical proposal.

2. Electric grid, Smart grid technology (implement)?

Answer: State qualifications in these areas as part of the technical proposal.

3. Separate contracts on hardware/software?

Answer: This is a professional services contract and hardware will be purchased separately.

4. What version of SAP is being used?

Answer: XI3.1/SP 3 & 4, Version V.12.4.0

5. What modules of SAP are running other than BI?

Answer: None.

6. Do you have 24/7 needs?

Answer: Yes.

7. It's a long list of positions, onsite or offsite?

Answer: The positions and locations will vary on the tasks that will be defined.

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8. Monitoring needs, how is this to be managed and will any purchases need to be made?

Answer: We will be having a network assessment completed via another RFP. Within that RFP there will be recommendations for monitoring tools established.

9. When will any new contracts begin? Will there be a transition period?

Answer: December timeframe. No transition period.

10. Will there be any interface with the City's ITS division?

Answer: Interface with the City's ITS will be done through DPU IT staff.

11. Will you accept proposals that might propose a better solution to your needs?

Answer: Yes.

12. With regards to the aggregate hours for various positions, is it possible to propose different costs for various specialties that may be within specific positions?

Answer: Propose per the fee table.

13. How many datacenters does DPU have?

Answer: Five, between all divisions.

14. Based on 24/7 needs is it possible to propose hourly rates based on weekdays, weekends, and holidays.

Answer: Propose per the fee table.

15. Section VII refers to references within the last two years and Section VIII refers to three years, which is correct?

Answer: Three years.

16. How are the tasks to be handled?

Answer: Task will be defined by DPU based on upcoming needs.

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17. Can someone propose on just those positions that they are strongest in?

Answer: Yes.

18. Are the hours on the fee table for one year or three years?

Answer: Three years.

19. How many physical locations encompass IT?

Answer: There are approximately 75 locations across all divisions. About 20 locations are manned

20. How many users does IT department support?

Answer: 1,800.

21. How many full time IT people on staff (incl. manager)?

Answer: 49

22. How many (if any) contractors currently working with your IT Department?

Answer: Number of contractors varies depending on projects they are working on.

23. Cloud system planning; is there a cloud infrastructure in use currently?

Answer: No.

24. If cloud is in use, is it private or at a vendor's site?

Answer: Not in use.

36. Is the work anticipated to be on-site or can it be completed off-site at the contractor's facility?

Answer: Prefer on-site.

37. Will the project manager be required to work onsite or can the work be done remotely?

Answer: Prefer onsite depending on project tasks.

38. Do you anticipate task orders under this contract to be competed?

Answer: Yes.

39. Does a consulting need to show they have experience across all SOW areas or just the ones they desire to bid on during task order competition?

Answer: No, submit based on your organization's expertise and abilities.

40. Does the vendor need to select a small business partner prior to award or can these be added afterwards to meet the small business goals?

Answer: Prior to award.

41. With questions due only 9 days prior to proposal submission we would request a 1-2 week extension so that we can properly evaluate all answers and any potential changes to the RFP.

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Answer: Not at this time.

42. Will the city require that a proposed team be able to provide all of the scope of services shown in RFP pages 12 thru 16?

Answer: No, submit based on your organization's expertise and abilities.

43. Will the city be selecting several consultants to provide a grouping of services, and if so, how many consultant teams will be selected for contracts?

Answer: TBD.

44. Will the city be posting or providing a copy of the pre-proposal conference signin sheet from the June 27th site visit?

Answer: Yes

45. Does a subconsultant that is on a team, need to be certified with the City of Cleveland small business by the OEO as a CSB, MBE or FBE at the time of the proposal submission?

Answer: Yes, refer to Appendix D.

46. Due to summer vacation/holiday schedules in July, we would like to request an extension of the proposal submission that is due on July 18, 2013.

Answer: Not at this time.

47. The RFP is asking for expertise in many different categories. The market value of an expert in one category may be higher or lower than an expert in a different category. It appears that the important factor is the rate per hour. Would it be acceptable to return a rate sheet per specific category which a vendor is responding to? i.e. "a resource for Banner Customer Systems hourly rate may be different than a resource for Business Intelligence working with SAP", thus it would make sense to provide a rate sheet for Banner System and another rate sheet for BI with SAP.

Answer: Propose per the fee table.
