Program Description

- The Cleveland Department of Aging will begin taking applications for year 2010 grass cutting services on February 22, 2010.
- A combination of full time and part time workers will provide the service.
- Service will begin April 1, 2010.
- Service will be provided on a first come, first served basis.
- Every attempt will be made to complete the service within the grace period of the citation. Prior notice will be given to the client.
- There is no charge for the service. Workers do not accept tips. Donations will be provided for future services.

Client Responsibilities

- Clients must secure pet waste before service.
- Grass will not be mowed when pets and/or other animal waste is present.
- The client must notify the office when the service is not needed.
- Clients should call when services are needed.

Qualifications

- Everyone in the household must be 60 years of age or older. The only exception to this rule is if a member or members of the household are functionally disabled. In this situation the functionally disabled member(s) of the household may be under 60 years of age and must provide a medical certificate confirming the functional disability.
- The house may be a single or two family dwelling, however, it must be owner occupied, located within the City of Cleveland, and still meet the above qualifications.
- Priority is given to frail, isolated, disabled and very low-income persons (using HUD guidelines).
