Using your new Waste and Recycle Carts is as easy as 1-2-3!

STEP 1: Use Black or Grey Cart for Garbage ONLY!

Bag all household garbage such as food; TV dinners and trays; pizza boxes; Styrofoam (plates, cups and boxes); diapers; clothing; etc. and place them in the Grey or Black Waste Cart.

STEP 2: Use Blue Cart for Recycling ONLY!

Rinse all cans, glass or plastic bottles, and glass or plastic containers before bagging in A blue, white or clear plastic bag. Place bagged recyclables

in the blue cart. Recycle jars or plastic bottles with the numbers 1–7 marked on the bottom with the recycle symbol. Bag or bundle papers, flatten cardboard, and place on top of other recyclable items in the blue recycle cart.

STEP 3: Place Carts Properly on the Curb

Roll your carts to the curb and place them 3 feet apart with the handle toward the house and the metal bar toward the street.

DO set out carts for clean and efficient pickup



Please set your carts out with the handle facing the house. This allows the automated truck to handle the cart quickly and efficiently collect waste.
