## **October is Designated National Weatherization Month** Cleveland to Host Weatherization Fair on October 28, 2009

CLEVELAND – Mayor Frank G. Jackson today announced Cleveland’s participation in a nation wide effort to call attention and educate the public on the importance of home and apartment weatherization measures.

“We are inviting Cleveland residents of all ages to stop in City Hall to learn first hand how to reduce their home and apartment energy costs through weatherization measures,” said Mayor Jackson. “We will have a skilled team of professionals from the City and private sector on hand to educate attendees on how they can stretch their energy dollars through a number of weatherization services and programs.

The City’s Weatherization Fair will be held in the Cleveland City Hall Rotunda, 601 Lakeside Avenue, on Thursday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, from 9 a.m. to 3.p.m. Reduced parking will be limited on the Willard Park Parking Lot directly behind City Hall.

The Weatherization Fair will include information tables staffed by representatives from area contractors, financial institutions, and the City’s Department of Community Development. Scheduled Home Maintenance Workshops will be held from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. in City Hall’s Room. City staff will be on hand to provide assistance for those interested in filling out applications for the Home Weatherization Assistance program (HWAP).

Free weatherization kits along with refreshments will be provided as well as prize drawings.
