

### **Plan Objectives**

- 1. Identify updated recommendations for a **connected bicycle network** that complements the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's NextGen transit system, including all-ages-and-abilities priority connections, with a prioritized project slate for three-year implementation.
- 2. Identify priority infrastructure improvements to increase pedestrian safety and accessibility.
- 3. Create **programmatic and policy recommendations** to increase multimodal activity in Cleveland.
- 4. Develop **identity and aesthetic design standards** for the citywide Midway Separated Bikeway Network.
- 5. Integrate ongoing mobility work and new recommendations into a cohesive, 5-year **prioritization** and implementation strategy for equitable improvements.



### **Scope of Services**

#### City-provided Content:

Integration of existing plans and recommendations; maintenance strategy; organizational structure; speed management strategy; TOD and TDM policy recommendations; reporting structure

#### Consultant Tasks:

- 1. Project Management: meeting agendas and facilitation, file management, invoicing
- 2. Equitable Engagement and Outreach: steering committee engagement (three workshops) and resident engagement (two rounds)
- 3. Vision and Goals: consensus vision and goals, communications plan, identity & branding
- 4. Existing Conditions and Background: bicycle and pedestrian crash analysis, equity analysis, bicycle connectivity and stress analysis, pedestrian needs assessment
- 5. Recommendations
  - 1. Infrastructure, Programs, and Policies: bikeway network update with focus on AAA connectivity; pedestrian enhancements; other infrastructure improvements; policies that encourage mode shift, add bicycle parking, and inform design
  - 2. Midway Identity Guide: brand identity, network definition, aesthetic treatments, wayfinding
- 6. Prioritization and Implementation Plan: identify short-, medium-, and long-term priorities for plan's five-year duration
- 7. Final Plan Development: plan document drafting, refinement, and finalization



## **Scoring**

- Experience and Work Product (20 points): Work products and deliverables align with the City's mobility goals. Provides evidence of similar services performed successfully in other cities.
- **Project Approach** (20 points): Firm(s) approach projects in such a way that align with the City's values.
- Capacity (20 points): Key staff and personnel can perform requested planning tasks and deliver products on time and on budget.
- Cultural Competency, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging (15 points): Firm(s) demonstrate a
  commitment to continuous learning and listening as it relates to cultural competency. Demonstrate a
  working knowledge on how to operationalize equity, inclusion and belonging with internal team dynamics
  as well as work products and deliverables, especially as expressed in the community engagement
  strategy.
- **Key Staff** (25 points): Key staff and personnel are qualified and demonstrate excellence in work products and deliverables.



## **Anticipated Timeline**

The City has set a 10 to 12 month timeline for the planning process. The project budget is \$200,000. Budget proposals may include additional alternates to be authorized if supplemental funding is available.
