Financial Assistance Programs for People Covered by Medicare

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### **Medicare Savings Programs**

Also known as Medicare Premium Assistance Programs (MPAP)

If you do not qualify for full Medicaid, you may qualify for other assistance programs. There are four kinds of Medicare Savings Programs that help those with low income and asset levels pay for health care coverage. Note: You must meet certain income and asset limits to qualify

#### **Medicaid**

Medicaid helps with medical costs and other services for some people with limited income and resources.

- All deductibles and coinsurance that Medicare does not pay.
- Medicare Part B premium: \$174.70/month for most people in 2024.

#### **Medicaid Eligibility**

	Single	Married
Monthly Income:	\$963	\$1,435
Total Resources:	\$2,000	\$3,000

### Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB)

The QMB program serves as a free Medicare supplement policy. QMB pays:

- All deductibles and coinsurance that Medicare does not pay.
- Medicare Part B premium: \$174.70/month for most people in 2024.

#### **QMB Eligibility**

	Single	Married
Monthly Income:	\$1,275	\$1,724
Total Resources:	\$9,430	\$14,130

### **Specified Low Income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB)**

The SLMB program has higher limits than QMB. Once you qualify, SLMB pays:

- Medicare Part B premium: \$174.70/month for most people in 2024.
- Retroactive Part B premium amounts for each of the past three months.

#### **SLMB Eligibility**

	Single	Married
Monthly Income:	\$1,526	\$2,064
Total Resources:	\$9,430	\$14,130

### **Qualified Individual (QI)**

Medicaid, QMB and SLMB are guaranteed for those who qualify, but QI benefits are limited.

QI pays the Medicare Part B premium: \$174.70/month for most people in 2024.

#### **QI Eligibility**

	Single	Married
Monthly Income:	\$1,715	\$2,320
Total Resources:	\$9,430	\$14,130

Note: Income amounts include \$20 monthly income disregard.

### Qualified Disabled and Working Individuals (QDWI)

If you are under age 65, disabled, and no longer entitled to free Medicare Hospital Insurance Part A solely because you successfully returned to work, you may be eligible for a program that helps pay your Medicare Part A monthly premium.

### **Applying for Benefits**

The Medicaid application determines eligibility to receive benefits from any of the programs listed on this brochure.

- Get the application from your county Department of Job & Family Services.
   Complete and return it in person or by mail.
- An interview may be required. A friend or family member can accompany you.
- An authorized representative can go to the interview in your place.
- Benefits cannot be denied due to nonattendance at the interview.
