The Office of Equal Opportunity (OEO) Schedules 1-4 must be filled out completely and submitted as part of the bid:

- All schedules must be signed and dated.
- If any schedule is not applicable, mark "N/A" on the schedule.
- Each prospective subcontractor must complete, sign, date and submit Schedule
   2 (Certified MBE/FBE/CSB Subcontractor Participation Commitment) to the prime contractor as part of bid proposal. If there are no prospective subcontractors, the prime contractor must mark N/A, sign and date schedule.
- If box 2 is checked on Schedule 4 (CSB/MBE/FBE Subcontractor Unavailability/ Impracticality Certification) the Prime Contractor must provide a detailed explanation in Section B.

## Answers to questions received:

Do we need a bid bond for each location if bidding on more than one location?

Answer: No, only one bid bond is needed and must be 5% of the bid total. Also, see Instructions to Bidders, A-4 and Section C – Supplemental General Conditions, C-2 B.

2. Will we need a performance bond for all locations.

Answer: No, see General Conditions, B-8.

3. Who should we call for notification that we will attend the site visits?

Answer: Call the contact person listed in Section D – Detail Specifications, D-11.

4. What location is Bid Item #3 that was already awarded?

Answer: Bid Item #3 was awarded in 2023 and it is the Harvard Service Center location.

5. Contract Duration: Could you please confirm whether the bid we are submitting is intended for a one or two-year contract? This clarification is essential as we've observed duplications in scheduled items, such as lawn maintenance, where quantities appear to be doubled (e.g., 70 or 80). Understanding the contract duration will help us accurately allocate resources and provide the best possible service.

Answer: The contract, if any, shall be for a period of two years.

6. There were addresses I entered a Google search for and were unable to determine a location. When I google Water Pollution Control, I get the home page and the address on Kirby. I saw on the site West 3<sup>rd</sup> was a project. West 5<sup>th</sup> is a new apartment building in Tremont, I wonder if WPC did work there as well? Please provide the locations. The addresses are listed below.

Water Pollution Control Station Addresses:

- Service Yard: 2900 West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44113
- Mary Street: 2539 West 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44113
- Front Street: 1110 Front Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44143

Answer: Those are our pump stations. Some of the addresses can be a bit confusing. Mary and Front Street do not have grass anymore. West 3<sup>rd</sup> has a section of about 6' X 5'.
