The Cleveland Division of Recreation wishes you an enjoyable season of Fall Softball.
Below are a few guidelines you should know:

Medical Coverage: There is **NO** medical coverage for the 2019 Fall Adult Softball Program.

Player Eligibility: You must have a validated contract card before playing in a game.
Your manager must have a copy of the contract card at every game.
Players must have a photo ID available at every game.

Eligibility Checks: League Director will send a representative to check contract cards during the season and in the playoffs. Players must show ID and their contract card.

Illegal participants AND the team manager will be suspended for four games and the team will forfeit all victories in which an illegal participant played. Illegal players in the post season playoffs will result in team manager and player to be suspended indefinitely.

Unsportsmanlike Conduct will not be tolerated. Also, alcoholic beverages are prohibited in Brookside Park; smoking is prohibited on the field or in the dugout.
